RIO GRANDE COUNTY CAMPING REGULATION

- Property owners and their guests, with written notarized permission, may camp on private property for up to 180 days per calendar year.
- A camping unit may only remain on the property when there is an active camping permit. (Camping units cannot be stored upon vacant property).
- o Property owner must have a permitted driveway and a legal address posted.
- Property must be no less than ½ acre.
- o Property owners with adjacent parcels cannot relocate to circumvent time limitations.
- o Trash must be managed onsite and shall be removed during and upon completion of camping.
- Sewage must be managed in a sanitary manor.
